Hereby stated the following

- The last 16th of May Pharmalink informed us that Czech Authorities made a withdrawal of samples at their facilities to conduct a counter-analysis on the presence or absence of particular steroid betamethasone. As we stated earlier, our product does not contains betamethasone. To check that, we performed an analysis of the same batch (Blue cap cream H-14) at an independent laboratory here in Spain. The results are conclusive as can observe and indicate that the product does not contain corticosteroids.(please,see the attached analysis).
- Given the very low concentrations that are said to have found of the corticoid, we suspected that this part could be due either to contamination in the process of a faulty analysis or detection of a substance with a similar retention time.

Among the ingredients of Blue Cap Cream is the Binea Parfum, which has over 25 different aromatic components together or separately capable of being responsible for the peak is said to have detected (Please find attached the IFRA certificate of the parfum).

- As we informed to Pharmalink to avoid these problems in the future, we have decided to change the BINEA perfume to HAPPYNES perfume, given that it has less aromatic ingredients and allergens, so could avoid misinterpretation. Therefore, to avoid any damage to our brand (catalysis and blue cap), we will propose to make a voluntary recall of the product. To change the product with the new perfume and also change the packaging in compliance with the Regulation (EC) Nº1223/2009. Then we will place on the market slowly with previous analysis of corticosteroids of each new batch of the product but always with previous acceptance of your authorities, during the first year.
